High Standards: Uniform and Presentation

I am writing to thank you for your continued support regarding uniform and presentation. In order to support further our high standards across the school, we have decided to introduce a 'First Impressions' card. This will be given to every student in the school and will help to record incidents where students are failing to comply with our high expectations regarding their uniform and presentation. It will also act as an opportunity for us to acknowledge those students who are consistent in meeting our high expectations.

The card will work in the following way:

Students will be expected to carry, at all times, their 'First Impressions' card in their blazer pocket.

Those who consistently meet our expectations and whose card therefore remains unsigned, will be rewarded via e-praise at the end of each half term.

Students who do not meet these expectations will have incidents recorded on their card with a signature and a date.

Where a student has already received two warnings in the form of a signature, on the third occasion, they will be internally excluded until the matter is resolved. This is a response to those students who are consistently defiant in terms of uniform and presentation.

We expect that that the vast majority of students will receive recognition for their excellent appearance.
