Buckfast Abbey – Tuesday 24 September 2019

We have arranged a trip to Buckfast Abbey to help the students with their GCSE Religious Studies course. Our visit will afford students the opportunity to experience life in a Christian community dedicated to creating a beacon of peace, love and understanding. It is a vital support for high performance in Paper One of the final GCSE examination. The students will have a tour of the Abbey church to gain understanding of how a physical build can express deeply held metaphysical beliefs, and the opportunity to meet and question a monk of the community. Our students will also participate in a stained glass workshop on the Windows of Wonder. This will create an unforgettable learning experience for the students.

Students should bring a packed lunch with any drinks/snacks they require for the day. **The cost is £9.50** (non-refundable) and includes the education session, insurance and mini bus. Students should wear full Haygrove school uniform- attendance will be refused to those who do not - and bring a warm, waterproof coat for the tour outside the Abbey church. We will be leaving Haygrove at 9.00am and we will return to Haygrove at 3.00pm. Members of Haygrove staff will accompany the students.

Students entitled to FSM may also be eligible for further support, dependent upon individual circumstances and the specific learning needs identified by the school. Please contact finance before applying. All places on this visit are subject to good attendance and behaviour and the head of year has the right to withdraw a student from a visit if these criteria are not met.

7. Data Protection. Haygrove School Academy Trust, as the data controller, will fulfil its data protection obligations by treating all personal data, held manually and on computerised administrative systems, with due care and confidentiality. Personal data will only be disclosed in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998, and the purposes registered by Haygrove School Academy Trust. Data collected is used for registration and monitoring purposes, and emergency contact information.

Declaration
