Some examples of how the new grades would work are as follows:

In KS3 – progress

Fred finished Y9 English with a grade of 7a. His equivalent current achievement grade using the new GCSE grades would be 5- (a low grade 5).

Hayley finished Y7 Maths at 5b. Her equivalent current achievement using the new GCSE grades would be 2+ (a high grade 2)

In KS4 (based on Target projections from KS2 results) – predicted

James was awarded a secure Target grade of A\* using the old GCSE grades, his new target would be 9.

Jemima was awarded a hopeful target grade of C using the old GCSE grades, her new target would be 4.
