- Camp Site** The Guide Association, Princess Mary House, Foxlease, Lyndhurst Hampshire SO43 7DE
Tel: 02380 282638. Foxlease is in Lyndhurst on the A377 in the heart of the New Forest. The 65 acres of grounds provides a safe and spacious campsite and there is a heated swimming pool on the site.
- Luggage** Please pack clothes in a soft bag with no sharp corners that will damage the groundsheet of the tent. Suitcases are not suitable.
- Pocket Money** A little for sweets/souvenirs. Children are expected to look after their own money and keep it in a secure zipped pocket.
- Valuables** Please convince your child that they will survive for three days without their iPod. If students wish to bring their mobile phone, please be aware there is nowhere to charge them and signal is limited in the forest. These items are not covered on the School's insurance if they are lost or broken. Please leave them at home, as lost or broken items spoil camp.
- Behaviour** A high standard of behaviour is required at all times, children are expected to act with courtesy and consideration to each other and to anyone they meet. They must respect the Country Code. Silence between the hours of 11.00pm and 7.00am is essential if they are to have a good night's rest.

PERSONAL KIT LIST

We expect students to dress in smart casual clothes on camp. Combat jackets, chains, studs, huge baggy flared trousers, ripped jeans and unsuitable logos are NOT acceptable.

- 1 Sleeping bag & Roll Mat
- 2 Night clothes
- 3 Wash Kit - soap/shower gel, flannel, two towels, brush/comb, toothpaste and toothbrush.
- 4 **Waterproof jacket + trousers (jacket must have a hood) - ESSENTIAL.**
- 5 Activity Clothes - walking boots or strong shoes or trainers, trousers (leggings/tracksuit bottoms rather than jeans), sweatshirt, thick sweater/fleece, T- shirts (no strappy tops), shorts, warm socks, woolly hat, sun hat.
- 6 Day Sack (School Rucksack or drawstring PE Bag is fine)
- 7 Sun Cream
- 8 Water bottle (unbreakable please)
- 9 Tea Cloth
- 10 Torch - with spare batteries
- 11 Cutlery - knife, fork, spoon
- 12 Mug/Plate/Dish (unbreakable please)
- 13 Swimming costume
- 14 Small amount of spending money for souvenir, ice cream.



If you bring a mobile phone you are responsible for it, there is also nowhere to charge it on camp and it will not be covered on the school insurance if it gets broken or lost.

NO SWEETS OR SNACK FOODS ARE TO BE BROUGHT ON CAMP

Adventurous Activities : All safety equipment and clothing will be provided for these activities. Students must have suitable clothing such as tracksuit bottoms, leggings rather than just jeans, otherwise activities such as mountain biking, climbing, zip wire become uncomfortable. Students will be required to wear long sleeves on some of the activities.

Supervision : All activities will be supervised by staff from Haygrove School and qualified instructors from Foxlease. **IN THE INTEREST OF SAFETY, CHILDREN MUST NOT GO OFF ON THEIR OWN.**

Behaviour : We expect children to act with courtesy and consideration to each other and to anybody they meet on camp. Between the hours of 10.00pm and 7.00am, we expect all children not just to be quiet but also to be SILENT. This is only fair to others. If children are a nuisance during the night parents will be contacted.
